Care Cleaning and Winterizing

Ztrends showers are manufactured using Stainless Steel 304. These units require regular cleaning. Obvious neglect in regular cleaning will void the warrantee.

- You are welcome to use vinegar, oils, baking soda, dish liquid, glass cleaner, stainless steel cleaners.
- Deeper scratches can be sanded out of the unit using a very fine grade sand paper (lightly) and water. (320 grit wet sand paper)
- Any sodium buildup (salt) can be removed using Flitz.

The 304 Stainless-Steel Products are not coated nor have a finish on them.

Winterizing Showers – In severe weather states or States that experience below freezing temperatures, it is recommended that after you turn off the water supply you loosen the nuts on the back of the unit and remove valve from the wall. (Store in a dry location)

If removal is not possible, turn off the water supply, open the valve to drain, locate the hex nut under the handle (remove with an Allen wrench) unthread the lock ring and remove the cartridge. (Place contents in a bag and store in a dry location).

Faucets

Cleaning use the same directions as the shower for Faucets in outdoor applications.
